

Youth Conference Code of Conduct

Respect others: "Speak kindly and positively about others. Choose not to insult others or put them down, even in joking. Avoid gossip of any kind, and avoid speaking in anger. When you are tempted to say harsh or hurtful things, leave them unsaid. Always use the names of God and Jesus Christ with reverence and respect. Do not use profane, vulgar, or crude language or gestures, and do not tell jokes or stories about immoral actions." (For the Strength of Youth)

Follow the standards outlined in "For the Strength of Youth" Pamphlet. All clothes worn at camp must be modest. "Immodest clothing is any clothing that is tight, sheer, or revealing in any other manner. Young women should avoid short shorts and short skirts, shirts that do not cover the stomach, and clothing that does not cover the shoulders or is low-cut in the front or the back. Young men should also maintain modesty in their appearance." (For the Strength of Youth)

You can wear:

Pants, capris, or below the knee shorts
Shirts (must have sleeves, no tank tops)
Closed-Toe shoes
Modest Pajamas or sweats

"Dancing can be fun and can provide an opportunity to meet new people. However, it too can be misused. When dancing, avoid full body contact with your partner. Do not use positions or moves that are suggestive of sexual or violent behavior or are otherwise inappropriate." (For the Strength of Youth)

No electronic devices! Please leave them at home.

No nuts! There are some youth who are severely allergic to nuts. To keep them safe we are asking for your cooperation in not bringing any nuts to youth conference.

No sneaking out of cabins or you will be sent home. Respect others' need for sleep. Whisper after lights out.

Respect the campground and others' belongings. Leave everything better than you found it.
